Mike is a highly regarded Bible teacher and is the Director of the Centre for Biblical Preaching in Melbourne, which trains people across Australia and the world in expository preaching. He's married to Sarah and they have 4 adult children and one grandchild. To keep fit Mike likes to walk with Sarah to coffee shops, wrap his mind around cryptic crosswords and crime novels. He has written books on the cross from the Old Testament and in Revelation, an evangelistic book, one on the power of congregational singing and the 2004 Australian Christian Book of the Year *Stirrings of the Soul*, looking at spirituality. He has taught in Bible Colleges in Pakistan, Sydney and Melbourne.
